




### XV Youth Spring Salon


Our talented students showcased their amazing projects from the 2023/2024 academic year, demonstrating their commitment, hard work, and inventiveness.



Meeting with representatives from all over the world, this event allows global promotion of IBU and collaboration with different institutions.










### WORKSHOP FAIR OF CREATIVE INDUSTRIES




## INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL OF ART AND DESIGN (IJAD)


### **Erasmus+ Projects**

The book will be available for FAD students from the 2024/2025 Academic Year.








### **Exhibition visit**

Students visited the Faculty of Art and Design, where they were provided with information on the opportunities and qualities of IBU along with a tour of the campus.














## **GIFT FUND**

### Sakura festival



Prof. Maja Gjureska had designed the costumes for the dance performance "Remembering the Future", choreographed by Ivana Balabanova, performed in Zurich 2024. "Remembering the Future" is a dance piece that delves into the intricacies of memory, time, and the collective experiences that shape our identities. Through the fusion of physical and mental memories, the performance challenges the conventional understanding of time, suggesting a non-linear and even non-existent perspective. It explores the interplay between individual and collective memories, questioning the very nature of memory and its influence on our perception of the future.





### Costume Design for CODE #9

Prof. Maja Gjureska had designed the costumes for the dance performance titled as CODE #9, choreographed by Ivana Balabanova, that counts several international performances in the past year. In the following months CODE #9 will be performed in Argentina, Mexico and St. Petersburg. CODE #9 resembles an investigation and deals with how the different develop relationship with body can light darkness. Interdisciplinary approach with movement, soundscape and visuals projected on the ground. The piece is a continuation of the research process "Darkness" and takes the audience into an immersive state following the movement of the dancer.

The performance has been developed within two residencies in Barcelona, Spain ('21) and Skopje, North Macedonia ('22). It premiered in Zagreb, Croatia at "POGON – Centar for independent culture and youth" within the project Reg. Lab (organisations: "Kooperativa"-Croatia, "Pogon"-Zagreb, "Anibar"-Kosovo, "CSS Centar Jadro"-Skopje). The project was supported by the Ministry of Culture in North Macedonia and the City of Skopje.



# Costume Design for the Short Movie "The Script"

Prof. Maja Gjureska has designed the costumes for the short movie titled "The Script", directed by Aleksandra Kardalevska. "The Script" features several world-famous novel characters that get lost in the fantastic world of The Script filled with mysterious pages and existential questions.
